

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, in order to correct deficiencies in the Tribal Administration's computerized accounting system that presently compromise the reliability of Tribal fiscal data, and

WHEREAS, correction of these deficiencies will require computer software conversion and installation.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a P.L. 93-638 grant application be submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for approximately \$28,500.00 to purchase computer software and consultant services to effect the system design, conversion and installation.


The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
