

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, it is imperative to the economic and social development of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that adequate planning and grant development be accomplished, and

WHEREAS, planning and grant writing expertise within the Tribe is quite limited, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has indicated through resolution its intent to expend its control of natural resources and other activities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a P. L. 93-638 grant be submitted to utilize approximately \$33,000.00 in FY 84 P. L. 93-638 grant funds for the purpose of funding the position of a Natural Resource Planner/Grant Writer position.

The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
