## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe continually encounters damage and destruction of our boundary fences, and

WHEREAS, this damage is usually committed by trespassers who violate our boundaries for the purpose of poaching or stealing our resources, and

WHEREAS, the maintenance of our boundary fence requires considerable monetary expenditures for manpower and materials.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a P.L. 93-638 contract be submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to utilize trust services general funds in the amounts of \$10,000.00 for FY 83 and \$19,000.00 in FY 84 funds for the purpose of boundary maintenance.

The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountair Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
