## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

FINAL PASSAGE OF ORDINANCE NO. AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 129; EXCLUSION AND REMOVAL OF NON-MEMBERS

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Resolution No. 83-265, approved for public posting, a proposed amendment to Section 1003 of the Removal and Exclusion Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto, and
- WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to Section 1003 has been publicly posted for ten (10) days as required by the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe and no public comments have been received in opposition thereto, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the proposed amendment to Section 1003 will assist in the protection of the people and property of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and that final approval is warranted in the form attached hereto.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No.138 as an amendment to Ordinance No. 129 in the form attached hereto.

The foregoing resolution was on Sepgember 07, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
