

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Southwest Forest Industries in consideration for being allowed to cancel the McNary Sawmill lease in 1983 rather than 1990, has deeded, amongst other things, land containing two or more wells and a pipeline which service the town of McNary, to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has conducted a survey of the well and pipeline land which was deeded to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has presented a plat and legal description of the land containing the wells and pipeline that was obtained from Southwest Forest Industries for the Tribal Council's consideration and approval, and
- WHEREAS, Raymus Albert has conducted a spot check of the survey to the length and areas of acquisition which amount to approximately 12.225 acres, and
- WHEREAS, a copy of the legal description of the acquired area is attached to this resolution and is incorporated by reference herein, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is satisfied that the legal description and plat of the acquired land area from Southwest Forest Industries is accurate and constitutes that area which was agreed upon between the Tribal Council and Southwest Forest Industries which would be ceded to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the plat and legal description of the land acquired from Southwest Forest Industries.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby request that the Bureau of Indian Affairs record the plat and legal description of the acquired real estate with the proper County and State Agencies and that confirmed copies of the same be delivered to the Office of Raymus Albert and that of the Tribal Attorney.

The foregoing resolution was on September 07, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
