RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has on this date, interviewed three applicants for the position of General Manager for the Commercial Shopping Center, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has intereviewed extensively, the background, credentials and managerial objectives of each of the candidates for the position, and
- WHEREAS, there is a great need for a General Manager for the Shopping Center, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by secret ballot, has chosen George F. Walker, Jr. as best qualified for the position of General Manager for the Shopping Center, and
- WHEREAS, details as to conditions of employment and salary shall be negotiated by the Board of Directors of the Shopping Center, Personnel Department and the successful candidate, George F. Walker, Jr., and
- WHEREAD, Mr. Walker's permanent appointment to the position is subject to agreement of the aforenamed departments and Mr. Walker regarding conditions of employment and salary.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. George F. Walker, Jr. as the General Manager for the Shopping Center subject to Mr. Walker and the appropriate Tribal Agencies agreeing upon his working conditions, benefits and salary.

The foregoing resolution was on September 07, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 1 abst. 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
