RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that Mrs. Eva Kasey has resigned from her position on the Land Board, and
- WHEREAS, Raymus Albert, Chairman of the Land Board has suggested to the Tribal Council that they appoint a new member to fill the vacancy on the Land Board created by her resignation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed several persons for that position and has agreed that Mr. Sidney Baha is a fit and able person to fill the vacancy created by Mrs. Eva Kasey's resignation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to extend its appreciation to Eva Kasey for that time and effort she contributed to the Tribe while she was active as a Land Board member, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby appoints Mr. Sidney Baha to the Land Board subject to his acceptance of said nomination and appointment.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Sidney Baha to fill the vacancy created by Eva Kasey's resignation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby request the Land Board Chairman to immediately notify Sidney Baha of the appointment and to advise the Tribal Council of Mr. Baha's acceptance or rejection of the appointment at the next Council Meeting.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby extends its appreciation to Eva Kasey for the contributions of time and efforts she made to the Tribe while she was a member of the Land Board.

The foregoing resolution was on September 07, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
