

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service is desirous of entering into an interim Memorandum of Agreement with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Fort Apache Indian Reservation in furtherance of a project for further construction of the EPA sponsored sewer system, and

WHEREAS, upon completion of such services by the Indian Health Service, the community facilities will be transferred to the Tribe, and


WHEREAS, such facilities are needed for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Fort Apache Indian Reservation and benefits derived from such facilities will far offset any damages that may occur from the land taken.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declare its desire to enter into the Interim Memorandum of Agreement for domestic water supply and waste disposal facilities, including the waiver of damages for rights-of-way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council authorizes the Chairman to sign into such an Interim Memorandum of Agreement as approved by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
