

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Associate Counsel Contract
Robert Alan Hershey

- WHEREAS, The Tribal Attorney has advised the Tribal Council that he has money pre-budgeted for the employment of Associate Counsel on specialized or complex cases which may require additional attorney assistance in order to properly prosecute or defend said action or actions involving the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Tribal Council that additional attorney assistance is necessary in order to defend the Tribe in the Federal District Court Case entitled A & A Concrete, Inc. v. White Mountain Apache Tribe et al., now pending before the U.S. District Court, for the District of Arizona in Phoenix, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has recommended to the Tribal Council that Tucson Attorney Robert Alan Hershey is well qualified, willing, and experienced in all aspects of trial and appellate litigation and that he is willing to serve as Associate Counsel on the afore-named case as well as any other matters requiring attorney services pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Attorney Contract attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed and reviewed the terms and provisions of the Attorney Contract and approves said contract as to form and compensation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the employment of Robert Alan Hershey as Associate Counsel in the Federal District Court Case entitled A & A Concrete, Inc. v. White Mountain Apache Tribe et al., and any other litigation involving the White Mountain Apache Tribe which may require assistance in either Tribal, state or federal court litigation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to sign the attached Attorney Contract and to submit the same to the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised by the Director of the White Mountain Apache Elderly/Detox Center, that continued participation by the Detox Center in the Federally funded Community Food Programs requires that a written contract between the Tribe and the State of Arizona Board of Education Food and Nutrition Unit be entered into setting forth the respective rights and responsibilities of each party thereto, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed contract, as presented, a copy of which is attached hereto, and by reference incorporated herein, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves of said contract for the benefit of continuing and maintaining the Community Food Programs and other federal benefits authorized thereunder.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the Tribal Chairman to execute the "Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement", hereinabove referenced and attached hereto, between the Tribe and the State of Arizona Department of Education, for the contract term of October 1, 1983 to September 30, 1984.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Food Service Agreement signed Shirley Wallen, Manager of the Detox Center, Billy Kane, Executive Director of Human Service Center and Raymond Kane, Director of Elderly Care Program dated September 26, 1983 is hereby approved and ratified.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
