

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by previous resolution the Tribal Council directed that a proposed ordinance regulating private junkyards on the reservation be posted for public comment for a period of ten (10) days as required by the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws, and


WHEREAS, the proposed Junkyard Ordinance has been posted for more than ten (10) days and the Tribal Council has not received any public comments against final enactment of the ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Junkyard Ordinance should be enacted for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts, effective immediately, the Private Junkyard Ordinance to be number as Ordinance No. 140 .

The foregoing resolution was on October 20, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
