

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Council Member Raymus Albert advises the Tribal Council that the Cedar Creek Community Building needs insulation and that the roof is in need of repair and that roof repairs necessary to avoid interior damage and building insulation will cost \$4,000.00; and


WHEREAS, Raymus Albert requests that the Tribal Council authorize the expenditure of \$4,000 from Revenue Sharing Funds in order to repair the roof and to install insulation and the Tribal Council agreeing that expenditure of the Revenue Sharing Funds is worthy and contributes to the well-being of the Cedar Creek Community.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that \$4,000 be appropriated and authorized from Revenue Sharing Funds for the purpose of repairing the roof of the Cedar Creek Community Building and for the installation of insulation as necessary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to execute any and all documents to transfer the necessary Revenue Sharing Funds to accomplish and complete the repair of the Cedar Creek Community roof and to install insulation.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
