


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, under the provisions of P.L. 93-638, Contract No. H50C4202685 with the BIA for the construction of the Minor Flat Dam, there is a requirement for an archaeological survey of the dam site and the upstream area; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Federal Antiquities Act of 1906, the Archaeological Resources Protection Act of 1979, and 25 CFR, Part 261.2, a Federal Antiquities Permit from the National Park Service is required prior to making the archaeological survey; said permit to be obtained through the BIA Phoenix Area Office.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby requests that the BIA Area Archaeologist initiate immediate action to obtain the required Federal Antiquities Permit from the National Park Service no later than November 14, 1983; this expeditious action required so as to complete the survey before winter weather closes the area.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
