

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney, Robert C. Brauchli, advises the Tribal Council that his present General Counsel Contract prohibits him from appearing before the United States Claims Court or for being responsible for providing legal services in prosecution of the Tribal claims in Docket 22-H; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney further advises the Tribal Council that his separate Claims Attorney Contract expired October 6, 1983, and that his General Counsel Contract must be amended to allow him to represent the Tribe further as Associate Counsel in Docket 22-H; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to amend the Tribal Attorney's General Counsel Contract in order to allow him to further represent the Tribe in Docket 22-H as Associate Counsel.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves an amendment to the General Counsel Contract for Robert C. Brauchli, Tribal Attorney, so as to permit him to represent the Tribe's interest in Docket 22-H now pending before U.S. Claims Court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that all other covenants, conditions, and provisions of the General Counsel Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to sign an amendment to the General Counsel Contract of Robert C. Brauchli allowing him to represent the Tribe as Associate Counsel in Docket 22-H.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
