

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to quality judicial services for the youth of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the future of the Tribe depends on the healthy development of the youth of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes the problems associated with placing juvenile offenders in the adult jail, and

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, provides for the contracting of services under P.L. 93-638.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it requests from the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, a contract to facilitate the Youth Service Center in removing youths from the adult jail and to provide referral and rehabilitative services for such youth.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the authority of the Tribal Chairman with regards to this contract is to run concurrent with the term of the contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract authorized may be reviewed and amended before the Tribal Chairman's execution by the Tribal Council at a Regular Tribal Council Meeting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract is to commence on January 01, 1984 and is to be administered by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Youth Service Center.

The foregoing resolution was on December 14, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
