RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to quality judicial services for the youth of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the future of the Tribe depends on the healthy development of the youth of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes the problems associated with placing juvenile offenders in the adult jail, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes the need for an emergency shelter facility for the youth of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Director of the Youth Service Center has demonstrated initiative and ambition in raising operation money from non-Tribal Government sources for the Center, and
- WHEREAS, the Youth Center has requested the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for operating costs for the month of January and has justified said request in its budget attached hereto, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the request is worthy, but admonishes the Youth Center that Tribal monies for such requests are almost non-existent and that the Director must continue to obtain funding from private and federal sources.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appropriation of the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the operation of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Youth Service Center through the month of January, 1984.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Director of the Youth Center to continue all efforts to obtain non-Tribal funding for the operation of the Youth Center and caution the Director not to anticipate receiving additional Tribal money assistance due to budgetary restrictions.

The foregoing resolution was on December ¹⁴, 1983 duly adopted by the Tribal Council by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
