RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Tribal Council that resolutions and ordinances passed by the Tribal Council on December 14th thru the 20th, 1983 must be reaffirmed by the Tribal Council; and that said resolutions and ordinances were not completed by the Tribal Attorney within the ten (10) days required by the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney requests that the resolutions and ordinances be reaffirmed so that the resolutions and ordinances will be legally effective, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that said resolutions and ordinances should be reaffirmed.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms all of the Tribal Council resolutions and ordinances passed from December 14, 1983 thru December 20, 1983, inclusive.

The foregoing resolution was on January 11, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
