RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilwoman, Judy Dehose, advises the Tribal Council that there is \$24,522.00 available from Vocational Education 8% funds which would be administered by the White Mountain Apache Tribal JPTA Program, and
- WHEREAS, said monies would be utilized by the Cibecue Building Maintenance/ Adult Education Reentry Training Program, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that it must give its approval to accept these funds so that the funds can properly be delivered to JPTA, White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it should accept these funds and that they will benefit immensely, tribal members who will take part in the Cibecue Building Maintenance/Adult Education Reentry Training Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts funds from the Vocational Education 8% Program in the amount of \$24,522.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the JPTA Tribal Program to administer these monies for the Cibecue Building Maintenance/Adult Education Reentry Training Program for Fiscal Year 1983/84.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby delegates authority to the Chairman and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman to execute any and all documents necessary to accept these monies.

The foregoing resolution was on January 12, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
