## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, April 04, 1984, is the date set by the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the election of the offices of the following Councilmen positions:

DISTRICT I

CIBECUE, OAK CREEK, AND GRASSHOPPER:

ONE COUNCILMAN

DISTRICT II

CARRIZO, FORESTDALE, AND CEDAR CREEK:

ONE COUNCILMAN

DISTRICT III

EAST FORK, TURKEY CREEK, AND SEVEN-MILE:

ONE COUNCILMAN

DISTRICT IV

CANYON DAY, WHITERIVER, AND NORTH FORK:

ONE COUNCILMAN

and

WHEREAS, in order to insure proper compliance with the constitutional provisions pertaining to election procedures as well as the election ordinances, the Tribal Council Secretary is hereby instructed to post notices of the forthcoming election and prepare nomination forms for distribution to the candidates, and

WHEREAS, nomination forms be made available to the candidates beginning on Monday, February 13, 1984, 8:00 a.m., and

WHEREAS, the deadline for circulation of nomination forms be on Friday, March 23, 1984, 5:00 p.m.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the posting of notices of the forthcoming Tribal Election for April 04, 1984.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that circulation of nomination forms begin on Monday, February 13, 1984, 8:00 a.m. with a deadline of Friday, March 23, 1984, 5:00 p.m.

The roregoing resolution was on February 02, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VIII, Section 1 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
