WHEREAS, the dance is planned for the weekend of July 20, 21 and 22, 1984, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Palmer further request that they be permitted to use the old Tribal Fairgrounds at Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mrs. Jennie (Colelay) Palmer to hold a Tribal Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for her daughter on July 20, 21, and 22, 1984 at the old Tribal Fairgrounds in Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on March 07, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
