FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION




WHEREAS, the dates planned for the ceremonies would commence June 29, thru July 01, 1984, and

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Pinal further request that they be permitted to use the old Tribal Fairgrounds at Whiteriver on the above dates.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Pinal to hold a Tribal Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for their daughter on June 29 thru July 01, 1984 at the old Tribal Fairgrounds in Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on March 08, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
