

RESOLUTION NO. 84-80

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council had previously enacted Ordinance No. 136 which provided for procedures to be used by the Tribal Utility Authority before it disconnects a customer's water and sewer service; and

WHEREAS, customer experience since the Ordinance was enacted indicate that the procedures must be simplified, clarified and that a non partisan Utility Grievance Committee should be appointed by the Tribal Council to assure compliance with the hearing and grievance procedures; and

WHEREAS, the reorganization of the Utility Ordinance No. 136 requires that it be repealed and that the amendment be enacted in its stead; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the Proposed Amendment to Ordinance 136 and concludes that it should be posted for a minimum of ten (10) days for public comment as required by the Tribal Constitution and Bylaws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and


WHEREAS, pending final passage of the proposed amendment, Ordinance No. 136 shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that the proposed amendment to Ordinance No. 136 be posted for public comment for a period of at least ten (10) days as required by the Constitution and Bylaws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney to forward a copy of the proposed ordinance to the Tribal Utility Authority for purposes of obtaining their comments on the proposed amendment.

The foregoing resolution was on March 9, 1984, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
