RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Hawley Lake Community Building lease expires on March 01, 1984, and
- WHEREAS, the Hawley Lake Homeowners Association has requested that the Tribe grant a renewal of lease for the Hawley Lake Community Building and are agreeable to an annual rate of \$600.00 per year, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after consideration of the operational costs for Hawley Lake, concludes that the annual rate shall be fixed at \$750.00 per year and that the lease may be renewed for a period not to exceed five (5) years.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of the Hawley Lake Homeowners Association for a renewal of the Hawley Lake Community Building on the condition that the annual rate commening March 01, 1984 shall be \$750.00 per year and that the lease shall expire on March 01, 1989.

The foregoing resolution was on March 09, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
