

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Mabel (Johnson) Kasey, a tribal member living in Canyon Day Community has come before the Tribal Council and requested permission from the Tribal Council to construct a fence around an area adjacent to her present homesite for purposes of containing livestock, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to her request and requests Mr. Raymus Albert, Land Board Chairman, to conduct a survey, prior to any fencing of the additional area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mrs. Mabel Kasey to fence property adjacent to her present homesite on the condition that Mr. Raymus Albert first conducts a prompt survey of the land to be fenced.

The foregoing resolution was on April 17, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


