## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Ms. Daisy Lupe, the Director of the Chaghashe Day Care Center, has requested permission from the Tribal Council to make a funding application to the Tribal JTPA Program for three (3) full time aides necessary to provide proper care and supervision for the children at the Day Care Center, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after inquiry to Mrs. Lupe, concludes that her request should be granted and that three (3) aides funded by the JTPA Program are necessary to provide proper care and supervision for the children at the Day Care Center.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Daisy Lupe, Director of the Chaghashe Day Care Center to make a funding application to the JTPA Program for three (3) full time aides to be assigned to the Day Care Center.

The foregoing resolution was on April 17, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
