FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe supports the State Plan for Exceptional Education proposed and submitted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs which serves the interests of all Indian children which attend Bureau of Indian Affairs schools.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and supports the aforescribed plan for Exceptional Education for Exceptional Indian children on reservations throughout the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests the Tribal Council Secretary to forward this resolution to Dr. Charles Cordova, Central Office, Washington, D. C., Department of Education, Office of Exceptional Education.

The foregoing resolution was on April 24, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Tribe May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
