

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has been requested by the Cibecue Community to provide funding for a theater; and


WHEREAS, funds from internal resources are not available; and

WHEREAS, General Revenue Sharing funds are available for use in such worthy community development projects.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby approves the appropriation of \$30,000 to be applied toward the construction of a theater for the Cibecue Community; said funds to become available after due compliance with Federal Revenue Sharing regulations as to public notices and public hearings.

The foregoing resolution was on 04-26-1984 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
