RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the April, 1984 Tribal Election has resulted in three changes in Council membership; namely, Mrs. Marjorie Grimes, Mrs. Gertie Lupe and Mr. Herbert Tate, and
- WHEREAS, said councilmembers predecessors served on various committees of the Tribe in their positions as Councilmembers, which must be substituted by these newly-elected officials.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the replacement by Mrs. Marjorie Grimes, Mrs. Gertie Lupe and Mr. Herbert Tate on all committees held by their respective councilmembers predecessors.
- BE IT FURTHER RESELVED that said councilmembers should be informed through the Office of the Tribal Chairman of the specific committees affected by this resolution and any regulatory conflicts resulting therefrom.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
