## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council to improve the housing situation for tribal members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority has received an award for forty (40) rental units, (Project Az. 16-34), and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority desires a long-term lease on approximately forty-eight (48) acres of land in the Southwest Whiteriver to serve this purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman and the Superintendent to enter into a Lease with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority for Project Az. 16-34 (49 Rental Units).

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
