

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has updated its Road Construction priorities in Resolution No. 83-364, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council had set as a priority Residential Housing Access Roads, and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe also foresees a need for road construction in the Housing Project Areas of Southwest Canyon Day, Southwest Whiteriver, West Diamond Creek, East Diamond Creek, North Rainbow, and the East Fork Community, and

WHEREAS, the Roads Department is requesting a minimum easement of 60 feet.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following areas be included with the Residential Housing Access Road Priority, the minimum easement to be 60 feet:

AREA	LENGTH
Southwest Canyon Day	1,000 feet
Southwest Whiteriver	10,500 feet
West Diamond Creek	4,800 feet
East Diamond Creek	1,600 feet
North Rainbow	1,200 feet
East Fork Community	900 feet

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
