WHEREAS, Councilman, Alvino Hawkins, Sr., who is also a member of the Housing Authority Board of Directors, has requested Tribal Council authorization to attend an Indian Health Planning and Contract Conference in Reno, Nevada, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that this program may provide valuable information in respect to the Tribe's own Health Authority and Indian Health Programs in general.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Councilman Alvino Hawkins, Sr. to attend the Indian Health Conference and Workshop in Reno, Nevada.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that travel and tuition expenses for this conference shall be paid out of Council funds appropriated for this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
