## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has provided for the selection of a Chief Judge of the Tribal Court by the Tribal Council, in accordance with Ordinance No. 112, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Personnel Department has advertised the position of Chief Judge and has accepted applications, and such applicants' information has been presented to the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed all applicants for the position of Chief Judge and has voted by secret ballot, and
- WHEREAS, the current term of the Chief Judge position expired on May 5, 1984.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Marvin Ethelbah to the position of the Chief Judge of the Tribal Court of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a four-year term beginning on May 5, 1984.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salry and other terms of such tribal employment shall be those established through the Tribal Personnel Department.

The foregoing resolution was on May 21, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
