

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member, Ms. Marjorie (Kasey) Altaha has come before the Tribal Council and requested its assistance for the construction of a water and sewer line to her home in the area of Alchesay Flat Community, and

WHEREAS, Ms. Altaha financed and constructed her home without tribal assistance, but now finds it necessary to request tribal assistance so that water and sewer services can be provided for a healthy and sanitary home environment for her and her children, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that her request is made in good faith and deserving of consideration.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Tribal Utility Authority conduct a survey and cost analysis for the construction of a water and sewer line to Ms. Altaha's home and provide these cost estimates to the Office of the Tribal Chairman; whereupon, inquiries will be made for possible sources of financial assistance to construct the water and sewer line.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests Mr. Paschal Johnson, Sr., Manager of the Tribal Utility Authority to coordinate his efforts with the Indian Health Service to ensure that there is no conflict with any ongoing water quality plan for the area or with any surrounding homes.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
