

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a delegation of tribal members from the Cedar Creek Community has come before the Tribal Council for a third and final public meeting in respect to their request for Revenue Sharing funds for the construction of a new Community Building for the Cedar Creek Community, and

WHEREAS, the delegation has discussed the necessity of such a building which would include two classrooms, a conference room, bathrooms, and a science lab for students who are presently overcrowded at the Bureau of Indian Affairs School, and

WHEREAS, the delegation has explained to the Tribal Council that if they wait for Bureau of Indian Affairs funding it may take at least four years before these very necessary classrooms and the science lab are constructed, while in the meantime, the students will continue to suffer from overcrowding and lack of facilities at the Bureau of Indian Affairs School, and

WHEREAS, the delegation has distributed for study by the Tribal Council a proposal from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Development Enterprise to construct the Community Building at a cost of \$87,000.00, and

WHEREAS, after considerable discussion, the Tribal Council concludes that the request of the Cedar Creek Community for a new community building for the purposes they have explained to the Council are necessary and ver. worthy.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appropriates the sum of \$87,000.00 from Revenue Sharing Funds for the construction of a new community building for the Cedar Creek Community such construction to commence as soon as possible along the guidelines set forth in the attached proposal received from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Development Enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests the Tribal Administrative Manager to take the necessary steps to appropriate Revenue Sharing monies in the amount of \$87,000.00 as soon as possible to carry out the purposes of this resolution.


