


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Vice-Chairman Reno Johnson, Sr. approached the Tribal Council requesting permission of the Tribal Council to hold a Revival at Canyon Day by the Assembly of God Church, and

WHEREAS, the Revival has been planned to commence on Monday, July 2, 1984 and continue for two (2) full weeks.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the request of Vice-Chairman Johnson is hereby approved for a two-week Revival by the Assembly of God Church at Canyon Day beginning July 2, 1984.

The foregoing resolution was on June 28, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
