RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Hawley Lake Homes Sold to Tribal Members

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received information that some of the Hawley Lake Homeowners have proposed to sell their homes to tribal members and in exchange have requested the tribal member to lease back the home for a period of years to the homeowner whose lease has expired or may expire in the future; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, by previous resolution, declared that the Hawley Lake Homesite Leases will not be renewed upon their expiration and that no new leases shall be granted for an additional period of years; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reserved the Hawley Lake area for future use and that enewal of the homesite leases will not be conducive to any future tribal use for the area; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council shall further require its consent and review of any sales contracts prior to the sale of any Hawley Lake Homes to tribal members.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain
 Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that any sales
 or contract for sale of any of the Hawley Lake
 Homes to tribal members must be reviewed and
 receive written approval by the Tribal Council of
 the White Mountain Apache Tribe prior to its
 execution.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White
 Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby prohibits any
 lease back arrangement or like arrangement between
 any Hawley Lake Homeowner who wishes to sell his
 home and any tribal member who wishes to purchase
 said home.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs that a copy of this resolution be sent to the manager of White Mountain Apache Enterprise with instructions to refer any proposed sale of any

Hawley Lake or Hondah Homesite building to a tribal member to the Tribal Council for review prior to approval of the contract or transaction.

The foregoing resolution was on July 17,1984, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
