
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered such regulations, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached 1984/85 Tribal member Hunting and Fishing Regulations for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation as recommended by the Manager of the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on July 18, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f & i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

1. DEER

A. Whitetail

Season Date: December 8, 1984 - Jan. 6, 1985
Bag Limit: One (1) per tag holder per year
Legal Deer: Antlered Whitetail only
No. of Hunt Permits: Unlimited
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

B. Mule Deer .

Season Date: October 27 through Nov. 11, 1984
Bag Limit: One (1) per tag holder per year
Legal Deer: Antlered Mule Deer only
No. of Hunt Permits: *250 (Bona fide Tribal members only)
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

*PERMITS ISSUED BY DRAWING OF APPLICANTS

Applications must be received by September 28, 1984
Tribal members drawn for mule deer in 1983 are ineligible
for the 1984 Mule Deer hunt

2. TURKEY

A. Fall Turkey Season

Season Date: November 10 thru Dec. 2, 1984
Bag Limit: One (1) Turkey per tag
Legal Turkey: Any Turkey, either sex
No. of Hunt Permits: Unlimited
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

B. Spring Gobbler Season

Season Date: April 13 thru 28, 1985
Bag Limit: One (1) Turkey per tag holder per year
Legal Turkey: Gobbler only
No. of Hunt Permits: *200
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

*PERMITS ISSUED ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS

3. ELK

Season Date: *November 10 thru Dec. 2, 1984
*Permits will be issued on a first come first serve basis
with limited access according to the following:

Three elk hunting zones have been established for the
1984 elk season: Zone 1-(comprised of management units
1,2,3,8), Zone 2-(management units 4,5,6,7), Zone 3-(Ma-
nagement units 9,11,12). Tribal members will have the
option of selecting one of the three zones and must hunt
only within his/her hunting zone. Permits available per
zone are as follows: Zone 1 - 500, Zone 2 - 700, Zone
3 - 700. These permits will be issued on a first come
first serve basis.

3. ELK - Continued:

Bag Limit: One (1) Elk per tag holder per year
Legal Elk: Any Elk, either sex
No. of Hunt Permits:
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

4. BEAR

Season Dates: Year Long
Bag Limit: One (1) Bear per tag
Two (2) tags per calendar year
Legal Bear: Any Bear, either sex
No. of Hunt Permits: Unlimited
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

5. LION

Season Dates: Year Long
Bag Limit: One (1) Lion per tag
Two (2) tags per calendar year
Legal Lion: Any Lion, either sex
No. of Hunt Permits: Unlimited
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

6. ANTELOPE

Season Dates: October 13 thru 17, 1984
(Units 4, 6, and 7)
Bag Limit: One (1) Antelope per tag holder per year
Legal Antelope: Either Sex-to be determined
No. of Hunt Permits: * (Bona fide Tribe members only)
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

*PERMITS TO BE ISSUED BY DRAWING OF APPLICANTS

Applications must be received by August 31, 1984. Tribal Members drawn for Antelope in 1983 are ineligible for the 1984 Antelope Hunt.

Season Dates: March 2 thru 17, 1985
Bag Limit: One (1) per tag holder per year
Legal Javelina: Any Javelina, either sex
No. of Hunt Permits: *70
Legal Taking Device: Bow and arrow or legal firearm

9. PREDATORS/Fur Bearing

ANIMAL SEASON

Season Dates:	Year Long
Bag Limit:	Unlimited
Legal Animals:	Coyote, Skunks, Bobcats, Foxes Ringtail Raccoons
Legal Taking Device:	Bow and arrow or legal firearm

PERMITS NOT REQUIRED

10. SMALL GAME

A. Cottontail Rabbits

Season Dates:	Year Long
Bag Limit:	Ten (10) per day
Legal Taking Device:	Bow and arrow, shotguns, or rimfire weapons only

PERMITS NOT REQUIRED

B. Tree Squirrels

Season Dates:	October 13 thru 25, 1984
Bag Limit:	Five (5) per day
Legal Taking Device:	Bow and arrow, shotguns or rimfire weapons only

PERMITS NOT REQUIRED

C. Quails

Season Dates:	October 13, 1984 thru Feb. 23, 1985
Bag Limit:	Fifteen (15) per day
Legal Quail:	Gambels, Mearns or Scaled Quail
Legal Taking Device:	Bow and arrow or shotguns only

PERMITS NOT REQUIRED

D. Blue Grouse

Season Dates:	October 13 thru Nov. 25, 1984
Bag Limit:	Three (3) per day
Legal Taking Device:	Bow and arrow or shotguns only

PERMITS NOT REQUIRED

E. Migratory Birds: including
Doves, Waterfowl, and
Bandtail Pigeons
