


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with the proposed 1984-85 Game and Fish Regulations for Non-Tribal members, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered such regulations, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached 1984/85 Non-Tribal member Hunting and Fishing Regulations for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation as recommended by the Manager of the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on July 18, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 3 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f&i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 17, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

## COTTONTAIL RABBITS

Season Dates: Oct. 13, 1984 thru Feb. 23, 1985  
Bag Limit: Ten (10) per day  
Possession Limit: Twenty (20) Cottontails after opening day, of which no more than ten (10) may be taken in any one day.

TREE SQUIRRELS

Season Dates: October 13 thru November 25, 1984  
Bag Limit: Five (5) per day  
Possession Limit: Ten (10) tree squirrels after opening day, of which no more than five (5) may be taken in any one day.

QUAIL

Season Dates: Oct. 13, 1984 thru Feb. 23, 1985  
Bag Limit: Fifteen (15) per day  
Possession Limit: Thirty (30) quail after opening day, of which no more than fifteen (15) may be taken in any one day.  
Legal Quail: Gambel, Merns, and Scaled Quail

BLUE GROUSE - SPECIAL GROUSE PERMIT REQUIRED

Season Dates: Oct. 13, 1984 thru November 25, 1984  
Bag Limit: Three (3) per day  
Possession Limit: Six (6) Blue Grouse after opening day, of which no more than three (3) can be taken in any one day.

A SPECIAL GROUSE PERMIT MAY BE OBTAINED WITHOUT CHARGE FROM ANY RESERVATION PERMIT DEALER.
