RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council is advised that the Associate Judge position of George Garland has expired, and that either Judge Garland's term should be renewed or a replacement appointed for a term of four years; and,
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by secret ballot, has voted on the retention of Judge Garland; and,
- WHEREAS, a final tally indicates two votes in favor of Carol Williams as Associate Judge, and nine votes in favor of the retention of George Garland as Associate Tribal Judge; and,
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved the final vote and has declared George Garland as the successful candidate for Associate Judge.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain
 Apache Tribe that it hereby re-appoints George
 Garland as Associate Tribal Judge for an
 additional term of four years, effective
 immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on July 25,1984, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
