RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Canyon Day Representatives have determined that the best location for the Canyon Day Feed Lot originally designated for the Canyon Day area would be in the best interests of the Canyon Day people to be removed to either a location at the Upper Amos Wash Crossing or in the alternative in the proximity of Navajo Bill Tank which is east of Amos Wash of White River, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by one of its Water Development Engineers, Mike Watson, that water studies conducted indicate that there is an indequate supply of water at the Amos Wash location, but there is sufficient water for the feed lot operation at the alternate Navajo Bill Tank site, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Watson advised the Tribal Council that ten (10) to fifteen (15) acres would be necessary for the Feed Lot Operation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that the Navajo Bill Tank site near the White River is is a site formerly approved by the Canyon Day Community Community representatives, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that construction of the Feed Lot at Navajo Tank site should commence immediately.
- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and directs the immediate construction of the approved Cattle Feed Lot at the Navajo Bill Tank site, east of Amos Wash by the WhiteRiver and that ten (10) to fifteen (15) acres be set aside for that purpose

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Nountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
