RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Varnell Gatewood, Jr. and Linda Burnette of Diamond Creek Community have requested Tribal Council approval for Navopache Cooperative, Inc. to be granted a Right-of-Way to their mobile home so that electrical power can be provided to said home, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby approves said request and grants Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. a Right-of-Way to hook up electrical power to the mobile home.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Varnell Gatewood, Jr. and Linda Burnette for a Right-of-Way grant to Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. so that electrical power can be connected to their mobile home.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman to execute all necessary documents to grant the Right-of-Way to the mobile home located in the Diamond Creek Community Sub-Division.

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1984 dyly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
