WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby accepts Mr. Donald Booker's letter of resignation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further expresses its appreciation to Mr. Booker for his more than seven years of service to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the letter of resignation of Mr. Booker effective August 17, 1984.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby designates Friday, August 17, 1984 as the effective date of the resignation and that the position be advertised immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests Mr. Booker to thoroughly brief, Dennis Miller, Vicario and Hugh Lee in respect to all accounts and budget matters under his control and administration.

The foregoing resolution was on August 17, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
