

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney, advises the Tribal Council that the Legal Department is in need of a Federal Law Library in order to properly conduct legal research for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has distributed to the Tribal Council for review, a list of the law books necessary (attached hereto) and their prices to complete a Federal Law Library and other necessary books for the Tribe in the amount of \$28,343.00, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Council that he has written several letters to foundations requesting donations in order to purchase the law books for the library, but has received negative results so far, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney requests that Revenue Sharing Funds be appropriated for the purchase of a Federal Law Library with the understanding that the Tribal Attorney will try to locate used books first before purchasing new books, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there is a need for Federal Law Library and the books for the Tribe in order for the Legal Department to conduct proper legal research since the nearest such library is over 120 miles away.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of the Tribal Attorney for Revenue Sharing funds in the amount of \$28,343.00 for the purchase of a Federal Law Library and other law books itemized in the attached proposed purchase list.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that this date, August 17, 1984, shall be considered the first public meeting as to the use of Revenue Sharing Funds for this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
