## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Derl Tortice, a tribal member, has come before the Tribal Council requesting immediate, emergency approval from the Governing Body for permission to place a house trailer on Block #2, Lot 1, in the Post Office Canyon Sub-Division in the North Fork area, and

WHEREAS, this is an urgent request, due to health problems of a member of his family at the recommendation of the family doctor, and

WHEREAS, the Land Board has already approved the assignment for the lot in the Post Office Canyon Sub-Division.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in view of the above-described emergency situation it hereby grants permission to Derl Tortice to immediately place his house trailer on Block #2, Lot 1, Post Office Canyon Sub-Division in the North Fork area.

The foregoing resolution was on December 12, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
