

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rosalita (Henry) White, a tribal member has requested assistance from the Tribal Council to transport her cattle from San Carlos Apache Reservation to Chino Springs on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, she advises the Tribal Council that the Turkey Creek Livestock Association is unable to assist her, and

WHEREAS, Council members, Alvino Hawkins and Carlos Nosie represents the district in which Mrs. White resides and are willing to inquire into the nature of the problem with the Turkey Creek Livestock Association and determine in what nature Mrs. White can be assisted in the removal of her cattle from the San Carlos Apache Reservation to Chino Springs on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Council members Alvino Hawkins and Carlos Nosie to inquire into the problem and report its findings to the Tribal Council.


The foregoing resolution was on January 09, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
