

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, in a previous discussion, the Tribal Council had been informed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs that there were certain Bureau buildings which were excess to the Bureau of Indian Affairs and could be transferred to the Tribe under the provisions of the Act of August 6, 1956 (70 Stat. 1057), otherwise referred to as Public Law 991, 84th Congress, 2nd Session.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council being acutely aware of a severe housing shortage on the reservation concludes that it would be in the best interest of the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to request transfer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs buildings to the Tribe as soon as possible.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs transfer the following Bureau buildings as soon as possible to the White Mountain Apache Tribe; buildings located within the Bureau of Indian Affairs administrative reserve more specifically identified to be:

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe intends to utilize the houses for living quarters of tribal members and tribal staff.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe assumes all responsibility for future repair and maintenance of utilities and buildings.


BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes the reversionary provisions wherein if at any time while property conveyed pursuant to this resolution remains in the ownership of the tribe, the Secretary of the Interior determines that the property is not being adequately maintained or properly utilized by the tribe, or that the property creates a health or safety hazard or other undesirable condition, he may declare a forfeiture of the transfer and title to such property shall revert to the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman to sign any documentation necessary to effect this transfer to be effective January 16, 1985.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
