RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Vice-Chairman, Peno Johnson, Sr., has requested that the KNNB Radio Station provide him the opportunity every Thursday between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. to address the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regards to general information and activities of the Tribal Council, emergency matters from other tribal departments, tribal education, HIP housing, construction matters and other areas which are the particular responsibilities of the Office of the Vice-Chairman, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council acting as the Board of Directors for the Radio Station agrees with the Vice-Chairman's request and concludes that such a presentation by the Vice-Chairman on a weekly basis will provide a necessary public service to the people residing on the reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, acting as the Board of Directors for the KNNB Radio Station, that the Radio Station schedule Vice-Chairman, Reno Johnson, Sr., every Thursday for one hour, between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. for his presentation until further notice.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
