

RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Steve Williams, Tribal Administrative Manager, has submitted for approval by the Tribal Council, a funding proposal form required to be used by any Tribal Department or Enterprise wishing to apply for Federal Grants, and

WHEREAS, Steve Williams recommends that the form attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference be used in order to standardize Federal Grant applications, and

WHEREAS, further, the Tribal Council agrees that the form will be useful and assist the Council in the decision-making process regarding the priority and utility of various Federal Grant application proposals.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Funding Proposal Form attached herto and incorporated by reference in this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that all funding proposals made to the Tribal Council shall forthwith utilize this standard form.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
