


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has been recommended to the Tribal Council that uniform procedures be adopted for expenditures of Recreation Land Claims money and Revenue Sharing requests and that requests or proposals to appropriate monies from these two sources be first submitted to the Tribal Council on the Proposed Funding Abstract form previously approved by the Tribal Council pursuant to Resolution No. 85-23, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this recommendation.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it is henceforth required that all proposals for expenditures or appropriations of funds from the Recreation Land Claims Account and Revenue Sharing Account be submitted to the Tribal Council for approval and that all proposals for the use of these funds shall be submitted on the Proposed Funding Abstract forms previously approved and authorized by the Tribal Council pursuant to Resolution No. 85-23.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




