

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, SHIRLEY (BONITO LAVENDER) has come before the Tribal Council and requested emergency approval of a land assignment of her parent's old homestead located in the Seven Mile area; and


WHEREAS, Mrs. Quay advises the Council that she has already placed a mobile home on the property but wishes to avoid any possible conflicts or challenges to her placing the mobile home on her parents' old home-site by obtaining immediate Tribal Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with her request and finds no obstacles or conflict in approving her request on an emergency basis.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the emergency request of MRS. SHIRLEY (BONITO) LAVENDER that she be granted a homesite land assignment on her parents' old homesite land in the Seven Mile Community, effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
