

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Louise Fall, presently assigned to the Development Enterprise has requested she be permitted to return to the Central Tribe; and


WHEREAS, Mrs. Fall advised the Tribal Council that she previously transferred from the Central Tribe to Development Enterprise, but for reasons in regard to fringe benefits and other reasons, she now wishes Tribal Council approval for a inter-transfer to Central Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council in interest of employee harmony concurs with her request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe it hereby approves the inter-transfer of Mrs. Louise Fall from Development Enterprise to a position in the Central Tribe and that she be assigned duties similar to those she had performed before for the Central Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on March 13, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1985, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
